Russ Kuhns, Running Game Coordinator/Offensive Line Coach/Strength & Conditioning Coordinator/Special Teams Co-Coordinator



Russell Kuhns, a native of Bellevue, Ohio, is in his second year as a member of the Mustang coach staff. Kuhns comes to Silver City after three seasons as a graduate assistant working with the offensive line at Bowling Green State University.

As a student athlete in the linebacker and fullback position on the University of Wisconsin football

team, he earned three letters from 2000-2002. Kuhns played on the Badgers' 2002 Alamo Bowl and 2001 Sun Bowl and 2000 Rose Bowl championship squads.

As a senior, he caught five passes for 53 yards and had two tackles, including a forced fumble on special teams for the Badgers. He appeared in 11 games in 2001 and was named Academic All-Big Ten. In 2000, he was a standout on special teams recording nine tackles. In 1999, he was named Scout Team Player of the Year during his redshirt season. He began his collegiate career at Findlay in 1998 before transferring to Wisconsin.

A 1998 graduate of Bellevue High School, he was a three-time all-state honoree in football and wrestling for the Redmen. He also was team MVP in wrestling, football and track his senior year. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Wisconsin in 2003 and a master's in exercise physiology at Bowling Green University in 2007.

Marques Reischl, Passing Game Coordinator/Wide Receivers Coach/Academic Coordinator/Recruiting Coordinator/Freshman Mentor Program Coordinator/Game Management



Entering his fourth year on the Mustang staff, Marques Reischl takes on new responsibilities for the 2008 season. He now works as the passing game coordinator, wide receivers coach, academic coordinator, recruitment coordinator, freshman mentor program coordinator, and game management. Prior to 2008, he dedicated his time to the quarterbacks (2005-2006) and wide receivers (2007) separately.

Reischl, himself, spent 2001 to 2004 as the Mustangs' quarterback, playing in 29 games during his career. He combined for a total of 20 touchdowns and 2573 yards over the four years.

Upon completion of his senior season at WNMU, he competed for the San Angelo Stampede of the National Indoor Football League. He also had a short stint with the Johnstown Riverhawks of the American Indoor Football League before an injury cut his season short.

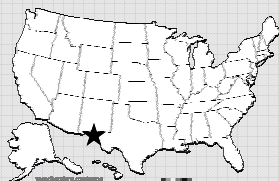
The Tombstone, Arizona native attended Tombstone High School where he was a multiple sport athlete (football, basketball, tennis).

Reischl received his Bachelor of Arts in Science Education in 2005 and is currently working on his master's in education leadership from WNMU.

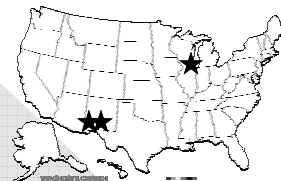

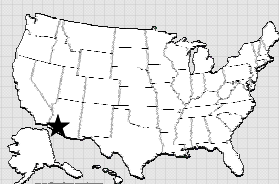

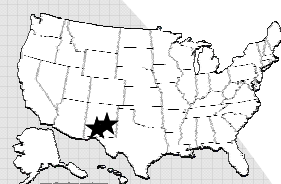

Chuck Kelly, Special Teams Coordinator/Defensive Line Coach/Financial Aid Advisor



Coach Kelly has been a staple at WNMU for the last 31 years as the Director of Financial Aid and as an assistant football coach. At Western New Mexico University, Kelly has worked with the linebackers and defensive line during his tenure. This season he will work specifically with the defensive line and special teams.

Kelly started his coaching career at the famous Mt. Carmel High School in the tough Chicago Catholic League. He was selected the Coach of the Year.

After a short stint at Wasau High School (Wisconsin) as a football coach and head wrestling coach, he joined the college ranks. Kelly worked with the linebackers at New Mexico State University and then went on to become the offensive coordinator for the Aggies under Coach Jim Bradley.

Kelly grew up in Chicago, Illinois and attended high school at the first place he coached, Mt. Carmel High School. He started on the "City Champion" football team and was selected as an all-city linebacker.

After high school, he headed west to attend the University of New Mexico where he was a three-year starting linebacker on the three-time WAC Champion Lobo football team. He can proudly say he was a significant part of one of the best teams in the history of UNM football. Kelly was a Second-Team All-WAC selection during his term there.

Scott Woodard, Athletic Director



They say an army is just as good as its leader. If that's the case, the WNMU coaching staff is in good hands. Scott Woodard enters his 10th year as Athletic Director for WNMU with high hopes. Woodard, a 1985 graduate of WNMU was an all-star shortstop at Western, and was twice named to the all conference team in the tough Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The Carlsbad, New Mexico product received his Bachelor of Science in Biology and his Master of Arts Administration.

"We have some extremely successful programs here, and we are striving to make all the sports very competitive," says Woodard. "We all (coaches) recruit the same areas, and I can honestly say for the first time since I've been here, we have a staff that is aggressive and will bring in top quality kids and those kids will leave Silver City with a quality degree and a great athletic experience."

Dr. Claudia Leonard, Faculty Athletic Representative



Originally from Detroit, Michigan, Claudia Leonard joined the Mustang staff in 2007 as the faculty athletic representative. An associate professor in the Occupation Therapy Assistant (OTA) program, Leonard first came to WNMU in 1997 and then took a break for two and a half years from WNMU before returning again in the fall of 2005. She currently serves as the academic fieldwork coordinator in the OTA department.

Leonard received her Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy from Eastern Michigan University in 1983. She then went on to earn her master's degree in business from WNMU in 2001. She recently completed her Doctorate in Occupational Therapy at the University of St. Augustine.

Victoria Stimac, Assistant Athletic Director for Media Relations/Senior Woman Administrator



Victoria Stimac headed south to take the reins of the newly created Assistant Athletic Director of Media Relations in the spring of 2007. Stimac handles the duties of sports information director as well as senior woman administrator and will coordinate community and university relations for the athletic department.

Formerly at Finlandia University in Michigan, Stimac was the assistant athletic director, senior woman administrator, sports information director, and head women's volleyball coach for four years.

Originally from Cedar Grove, Wisconsin, she played volleyball at Cardinal Stritch University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where she was a three-year volleyball starter as a middle hitter and co-captain her final season and majored in business and marketing.

Stimac is actively involved in the National Association of Collegiate Women Athletics Administrators (NACWAA) and the Collegiate Sports Information Directors Association (CoSida).

Roland Shook, Compliance Coordinator



Dr. Roland Shook held the Faculty Athletic Representative post since 1993 and was an integral part of the Athletic Department, as well as the university's academic department. Now in his retirement, Dr. Shook has the responsibility of the being the Mustang's compliance coordinator. His responsibilities as the compliance coordinator include scrutinizing each athlete's transcript

and signing off on their eligibility status and acting as arbitrator and investigator when student athlete, coaching or other athletics related issues arise.

Kent Beatty, Assistant Athletic Director



As a new school year begins, new jobs and responsibilities within the athletic department also begin. Head golf coach Kent Beatty has been promoted to assistant athletic director. Beatty will take over full responsibility of game management, facilities, and sports medicine.

"Kent has been with us for 11 years. He knows the ins and outs of this

department," says athletic director Scott Woodard. "He has had great success on the golf course with the men's and women's programs. I am confident he will have the same success in his new role of assistant athletic director."

Beatty will oversee all game day planning and management. He will also work directly with the maintenance department and athletic training staff.

Success has followed Beatty during his coaching career. Entering his 12th season as the head golf coach at WNMU, Beatty has learned many of the tricks it takes to lead a successful program, and it shows. Both his men's and women's teams are regular participants in the post season, an accomplishment which has been instrumental in giving WNMU's other athletic programs the confidence to succeed.

In addition to 21 NCAA post season tournament appearances and six conference championships in his 11 years at the school, Coach Beatty has mentored five all-Americans, seven academic all-Americans and five PGA golf professionals.

A Class A member of the PGA of America, Coach Beatty started one of New Mexico's golf dynasties at Ruidoso High School, a team that has captured five state championship trophies in recent years and continues to churn out top players that are also excellent students.

Beatty also serves on the NGCA All-American Committee and was the NMAA High School Golf Committee's chairman for seven years.

Alma Arellano, Athletic Administrative Assistant



Alma Arellano has become the glue that holds the athletic department together since her arrival as athletic secretary. She coordinates the teams' fundraising and travel accounts, while managing the student work studies. Her transfer from the Business Office has been a real asset to athletics as she is a real team player!

A graduate of Silver High in 1993, Alma received her degree from WNMU in office administration.

Meredith Drahota, Office Assistant



Entering her second year in the department but her sixth year at WNMU overall, Meredith Drahota, a four-year WNMU softball student-athlete, takes on new responsibilities for the 2008-2009 school year. For the past year, she has worked with the department's financials and game management. Drahota will continue her work in the office but also work on the softball field. As a

new assistant softball coach, Drahota will focus on the outfield.

Drahota spent 2003 to 2007 on the Mustangs' softball team, playing in 216 games. She currently holds three homerun records: most in one game (3), most in one season (16,) and most in one career (37).

Drahota received her Bachelor of Arts in English with a minor in History in 2007 and is currently working on her master's in business administration from WNMU. She attended Desert Vista High School in Phoenix, Arizona, competing in both basketball and softball.

Terra Strain returned to Silver City and WNMU in 2007 after seven years away. In her second year as a staff member, she assists the successful volleyball program and is full-time in the athletic training room where she works with the Western New Mexico women's programs.

Strain, a graduate of the Movement Science program at Western, wore a Mustang volleyball jersey from 1996-2000. During her four years, she was on the Gold Honor board each semester. She also was named to the Pac-West All-Conference Academic Team in 1999.

After WNMU, Strain attended Montana State University - Billings where she received her Master of Science in Athletic Training degree in 2006. She also was an assistant volleyball coach for the Yellowjackets for one year.

Most recently, Strain worked as an athletic trainer and head girl's volleyball coach at Bradshaw Mountain High School. The Virden, New Mexico native also coached for the Arizona Mile High Volleyball Club for one year and three years at Holbrook High School in Arizona. At Holbrook, she was the 3A North Co-Coach of the Year in 2002 and the 2004 1A-3A All-Star Coach in 2004.

Michael Stimac, Men's Athletic Trainer



Michael Stimac changes gears for the 2008-2009 school year. A part-time employee of the WNMU athletic training staff since March 2007 and a full-time employee of Gila Regional Medical Center in Silver City, Stimac enters the training room now full time.

Involved in athletics since the age of three and a former collegiate athlete, Stimac played hockey at Finlandia University where he received his Associate of Applied Science in Physical Therapist Assistant in 2004. He then went on to Northern Michigan University to get his Bachelor of Science in Athletic Training.

Stimac brings in previous athletic training experience from Michigan Technological University and Northern Michigan University, both NCAA Division II institutions and members of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC). At Tech, he worked with nearly every sport over his six years as a student athletic trainer. While at Northern, he worked primarily with women's soccer and football.

Stimac also has a great amount of rehabilitation experience. While at Gila Regional Medical Center, he rehabilitated a variety of ages within the in-patient setting. He also fitted and adjusted adaptive equipment for patients, provided wound care, and assisted in the instruction of back safety.

Prior to moving to Silver City, Stimac worked in therapy at Portage Health in Hancock, Michigan.

Bernie Busken, Head Football Coach



Busken took over the reins as the head football coach in the 2007 season after a three year stint of coaching on both sides of the ball, as well as the special teams for WNMU.

Coach Busken has achieved legendary status in the prep ranks in Arizona, where he was named "Coach of the Decade" in the 1990s. The (Mesa) Mountain View Toros won

three 5A State Championships under his tutelage and earned an impressive 82-9 record. During his 82 wins, Busken tallied 40 straight wins, setting the Arizona 5A state record. Three former Busken students are currently in the NFL -- Devin Clark (Washington Redskins), John Beck (Miami Dolphins) and Todd Heap (Baltimore Ravens). WNMU defensive coordinator Ronnie Heard also played for the San Francisco 49ers and the Atlanta Falcons.

At WNMU, Busken has coached the linebackers, offensive line and special teams. His defensive charges include some of WNMU's very best -- 2005 saw Valentine Chude dominate from his linebacker spot, while Christian Serena (a Busken recruit) was the RMAC Defensive Player of the Year in 2006.

Coach Busken's place-kickers have also been a bright spot for the Mustangs. In 2005, Kevin Hughes finished #16 in Division II in field goals. In 2006, Sean Sehnem was both an RMAC and National Special Teams Player of the Week courtesy of his 43.7 punting average and being #1 in the nation in field goals made per game.

The 2007 season also saw many highlights. Busken had four players receive six RMAC Player of the Week Honors along with four RMAC All-Academic selections. A total of 16 student-athletes were selected to the All-RMAC teams at the conclusion of the season.

In addition to his tenure at Mountain View, Coach Busken has coached at Duncan High School (Oklahoma), Fort Worth Country Day High School (Texas), Brazoswood High School (Texas); Farmington High School (New Mexico), as well as Millsaps College, Southeastern Oklahoma State, West Texas A&M and Southern Utah University.

As a player, the 1975 Missouri Southern State University grad started 42 straight college games and was a member of MSU's 1972 National Championship team. Busken was named as the MSU Lions' outstanding receiver in 1972 and 1973 and the team's most valuable player in 1973. He was named to MSSU Hall of Fame in 1992.

Coach Busken received his Bachelor of Science in Physical Education and his Master of Science in Secondary Educational Administration, while maintaining his outstanding athletic and coaching career.

Ronnie Heard, Defensive Coordinator/Secondary Coach/Special Teams Co-Coordinator



Ronnie Heard is the newest member of the Mustang football staff. As the new defensive coordinator, secondary coach, and special teams co-coordinator, Heard brings a wealth of football knowledge to the program.

Heard is a 2000 graduate of the University of Mississippi. While there, he was a safety for the Rebels and earned the Chuck Mullins Award and the Leadership and Courage Award. He was also placed on the All-SEC Freshman Team in 1996. He received his Bachelor of Arts in Business and Marketing.

After college, he joined the San Francisco 49ers (2000-2004). In his five seasons with the 49ers, he started 24 games and made six interceptions. Four interceptions came in the 2002 season, and three of those came in one single game versus the Arizona Cardinals. He intercepted Cardinals quarterback Jake Plummer three times, returning the picks for a total of 47 yards. For this, he was named the NFC Defensive Player of the week. In his final season with the 49ers (2004), he had a career-high 79 tackles, one interception, one fumble recovery, and six passes defended.

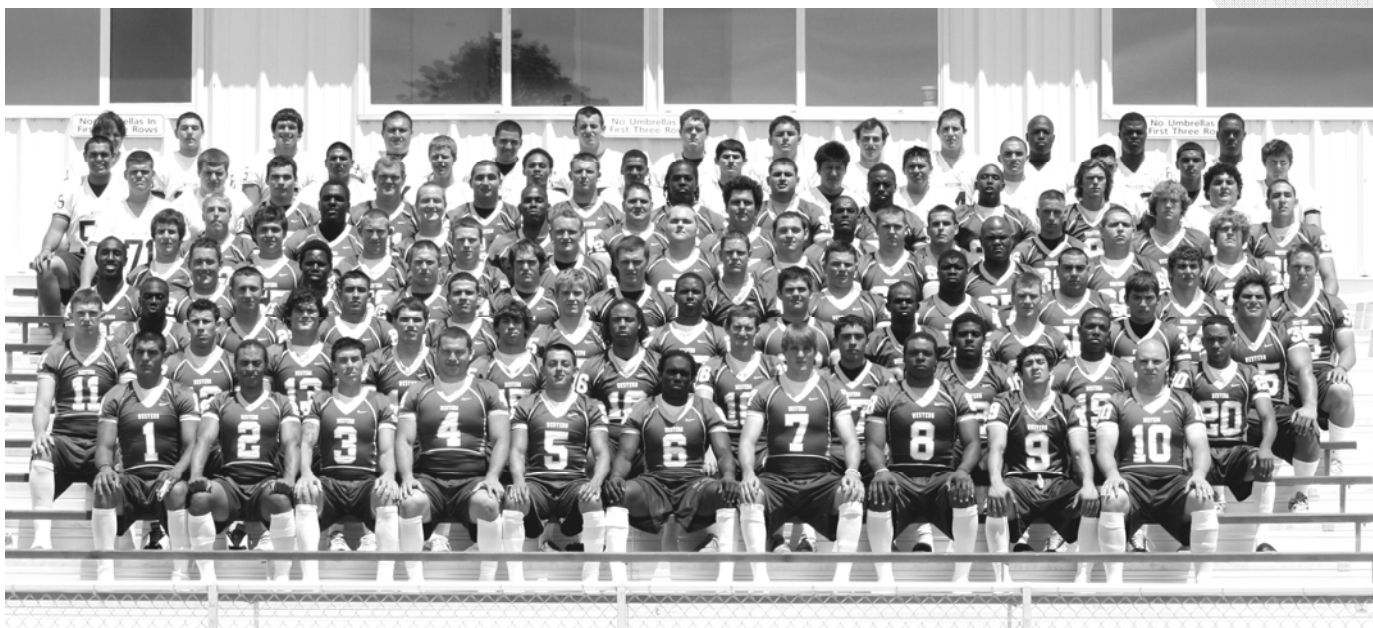
Heard then signed a one-year contract with the Atlanta Falcons, where he played in 16 games. He posted 29 total tackles. He was also named the special teams captain.

In his six-year NFL career, he played in 85 games, posted 218 total tackles, forced six interceptions, and marked 3.5 sacks.

Originally from Bay City, Texas, Heard played at Brazoswood High School where he was coached by current WNMU head football coach Bernie Busken, a member of the All-Greater Houston Area team, placed on the All-District team, a Who's Who Among American High School Students honoree, and a member of the dean's list. Heard graduated from high school with a perfect 4.0 grade point average.

## 2008 Season Preview

With a lot of new fresh faces, Western New Mexico University head football coach Bernie Busken is energized for this next season and the next four years. The Mustangs have 65 new faces, many of them freshman, and 112 players overall. In addition, Busken adds a new defensive and special teams coordinator in Ronnie Heard. "We are very excited about the upcoming season for our players and coaches alike," says Busken. "We have worked very hard in the off season and preseason and look forward to RMAC play." The Mustangs finished 4-6 overall and 4-4 in conference play during the 2007 campaign. This season the team is selected fifth in the RMAC preseason poll released in July.

### Defense

"Offense sells tickets, but defense wins championships." - Dave Thorson

With seven returning starters from the 2007 season, Busken hopes to see a championship. Three of the seven starters will find their home in the secondary: strong corner **Tony Norman** (Richmond, CA), strong safety **Billy Ray Weatherford** (Russellville, AZ), and free safety **Cameron Douglas** (Glendale, AZ).

Norman, a senior at 5-10 and 190 pounds, posted 38 tackles and forced two fumbles, returning them both back for touchdowns, last season. A junior, Weatherford is 6-3 and 200 pounds. He recorded 35 tackles and had one of the team's 13 interceptions of the season.

Douglas, the team's 2008 defensive captain, was All-Region two separate times in high school. He also was a member the 4A All-State team and participated in the 5A-4A All-Star game. Named Desert Sky Region Player-of-the-Year one time during his high school career, Douglas went on to Glendale Community College. Last season at WNMU he had three interceptions and returned them for a team high of 89 yards. He was second in the RMAC in interception yardage. He also had 34 tackles.

Others expected to make a contribution are **Steve Flores** (Peoria, AZ), **Robert Rodriguez** (El Paso, TX), 2006 starter **Clayton Dowd** (Scottsdale, AZ), and **Cooper Bowman** (Los Lunas, NM). "Cooper was an outstanding athlete at Los Lunas High School. He is a great, hardworking young man," says Busken.

Returning for his fourth and final season as a linebacker is **Darryl Horne** (Mesa, AZ). Horne ranked second on the team and eighth in the conference in tackles in 2007 with 69. He found himself behind graduated Mustang **Christian Serena** (Scottsdale, AZ) who posted 126 tackles. Horne also forced three fumbles. Helping him out in the linebacker position in 2008 is **Anthony Kahill** (Hollywood, CA) along with 2007 redshirt players **Colton Cisco** (Roswell, NM) and **Eric Zuniga** (Rio Rico, AZ).

Two experienced veterans will anchor the defense at defensive end: **Maurice Wells** (Tucson, AZ) and **Jamie Trujillo** (North Hollywood, CA). Wells, 6-4, forced ten tackles with a loss of 49 yards, second on the team last season. He also was fourth in overall tackles with 48. At 6-5, Trujillo had 4.5 sacks for 23 yards and 7.5 tackles for a loss of 31 yards in 2007. A 2007 redshirt **Erin Sharp** (Tempe, AZ) will round out the defensive ends to make the spot very impressive.

The interior defensive line will be manned by seniors **Theo Bystry** (Tucson, AZ) and **Justin Giacoletti** (Safford, AZ). Bystry competed in all ten games last season, posting 21 tackles. Helping out Bystry and Giacoletti will be **Eddie Noriega** (El Paso, TX), **Steven Spitulski** (Modesto, CA), and **Juan Esparza** (El Paso, TX). "Stephen is a big, fast, dominating defensive lineman who will have a chance to contribute this fall," says Busken. "Juan comes to us from a hardworking program and has worked very hard so far this fall."

### Offense

While you need great defense to win championships, offense does a lot more than just sell tickets. It boils down to:

"The team that plays the best wins the championship."

The Mustangs will kick-start their offense with a new quarterback. Albuquerque's **Chris Voller**, a 6-4 redshirt freshmen, earned the No. 1 spot after spring ball while **Cody House** (Tucson, AZ) will also battle for time. Voller, a Valley High School graduate, was a four-time academic all-district selection in football and basketball, earning letters all four years in both sports. He was a two-year letterman in baseball and one year in track. Voller was voted Valley's Outstanding Fall Male Athlete in 2006 and was the Albuquerque Sports Hall of Fame Student-Athlete of the Year for 2006-2007.

Busken has a good core back in the running backs spot with junior two-year starter **Dakota Woodard** (Silver City, NM). Woodard averaged 4.1 yards per carry and 42.7 yards per game last season, with his longest coming at the Colorado School of Mines (23 yards). **Tramell McGill** (Phoenix, AZ) also returns after playing in seven games last season. McGill edged out Woodard with 5.1 yards per carry but came short with 25.0 yards per game. Redshirt freshman **Milt Cherry** (Aurora, CO) and fullbacks senior **Sean Tuiofu** (Ramona, CA) and redshirt freshman **Scott Kneisel** (Mesa, AZ) should expect to see time on the field says Coach Busken.

Protecting the quarterback and running backs are **Edward Johnson** (Austin, TX) at right tackle, **Everett Verigan** (Yucca Valley, CA) at left guard, and 2008 offensive captain and former junior college All-American **Collin Boulay** (Phoenix, AZ) at left tackle. As member of the offensive line at Glendale Community College, Boulay was an NJCAA All-American (2006); NJCAA Region I Offensive Player-of-the-Year (2006); NJCAA First-Team All-Region I selection (2006); Pre-Season First-Team All-American (2006); First Team All-WSFL pick (2006); and Grid-Wire First-Team All-American (2006). Johnson and Boulay each earned spots on an All-RMAC team in 2007 and should get help from transfers **Deb Nelson** (Gilbert, AZ) and **Eddie Felix** (Van Nuys, CA) in 2008.

The Mustangs averaged 243.9 yards in the air last year. Part of this was due to seniors **John Means** (Glendale, AZ) and **Carlos Miranda** (Peoria, AZ), who will anchor the receiver position again this season. Means was placed on the 2007 All-RMAC Honorable Mention team after averaged 12.5 yards per reception and scoring two touchdowns. Miranda averaged 14.5 yards per catch and 33.1 yards per game. **Alex Alaniz** (Salem, NM), **Scotty Crespin** (Socorro, NM), **Josh Means** (Glendale, AZ), and **Jake Morales** (Silver City, NM) will also see time at receiver. "We have a solid group of offensive linemen and receivers to work with this season," says Busken.

### Special Teams

Special teams captain **Tony Norman** will double-dip on both special teams and defense. He will be helped by senior **Steve Flores**, who should also see time on defense. Flores is expected to handle both the punting and kicking duties. He was a Second Team All-WSFL choice in 2005 and 2006 while at Glendale Community College. He was also an NJCAA Second-Team All-American in 2006. "Steve is an excellent athlete who also happens to be a great kicker," states Busken. "As a kicker, he has a very powerful leg with great range. Steve will be a great defensive threat for the Mustangs."

Snapping the ball to Flores will be **Theo Bystry**, **Clayton Dowd**, **Jake Morales**, and freshman **Marcus Santa Cruz**. Santa Cruz hails from Shadow Mountain High School in Phoenix, Arizona. A three-year varsity team member, Santa Cruz was a 2007 Honorable Mention All-Region selection. "Marcus will be an outstanding deep snapper for the Mustangs. He will make a great impact on the Mustangs," comments Busken.
